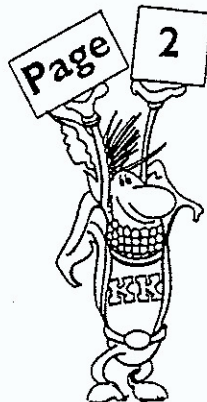
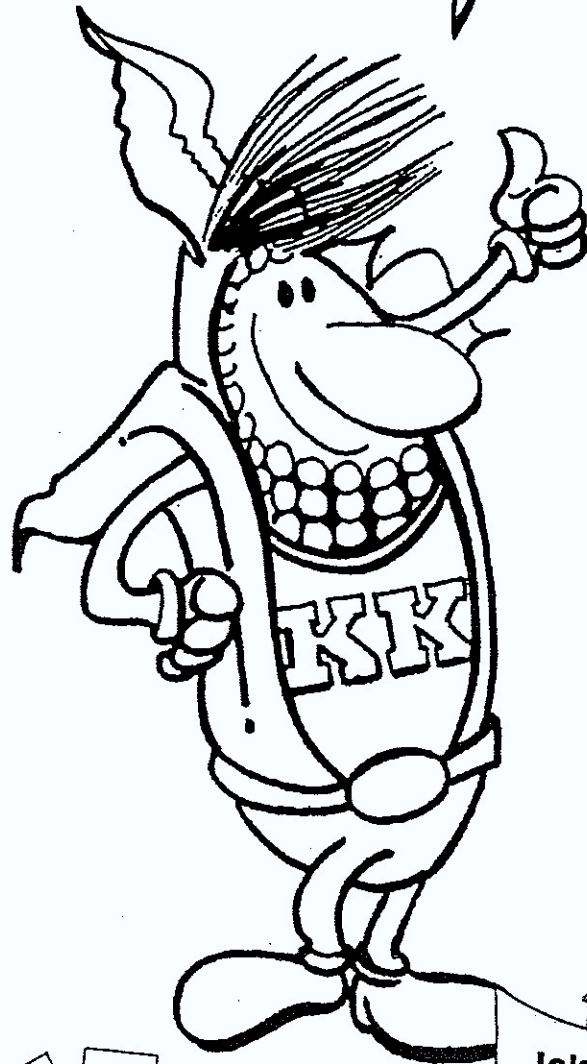


In My Crayons!

Kid Kernel's Classroom Maze!

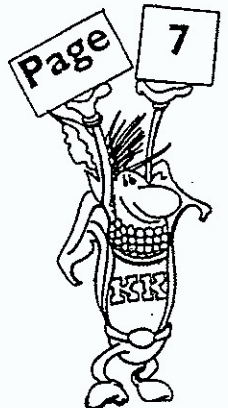

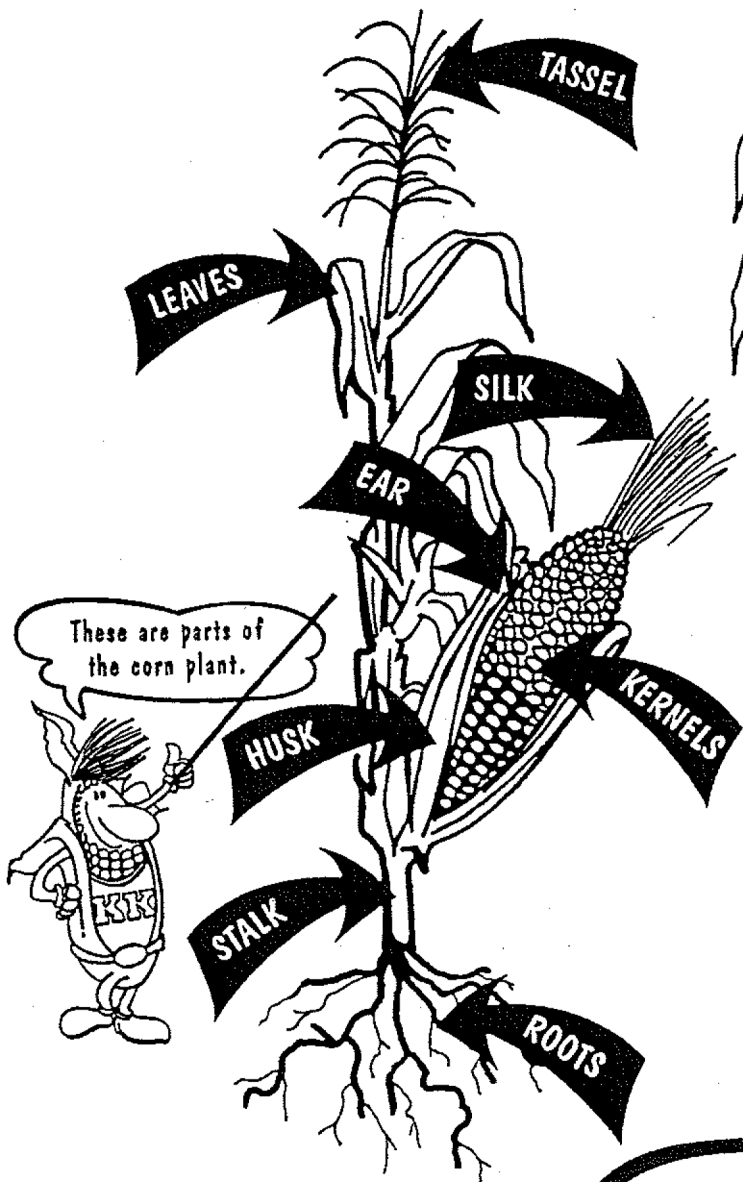
Kid Kernel has to find all the things in the classroom that have corn in them. Help him get from START to STOP.
